PLAINTIFFS ORIGINAL PETITION



TO THE HONORABLE JUDGE OF SAID COURT:

COME NOW, Jennifer Kay Harris and Michael Edward Anthony Harris, Plaintiffs, and file this Original Petition complaining of Kelle Rahm and Kelly Harrell, Defendants, and respectfully show the Court as follows:

I. DISCOVERY LEVEL

Plaintiffs intend to conduct discovery under Level 2 pursuant to Texas Rule of Civil Procedure 190.3.

II. PARTIES

Plaintiffs are individuals residing at 136 E Big Lake Road, Trinity, Texas 75862. Plaintiffs own real property described as Lot Fourteen (14), Block No. B of the CAMP BRANCH ACRES SUBDIVISION in Trinity County, Texas.

Defendants are individuals who reside or own property in Trinity County, Texas. Kelle Rahm resides at 162 Manor Drive; Trinity, TX 75862. Kelly Harrell resides at 346 Lakeside Circle; Trinity, TX 75862.

III. JURISDICTION AND VENUE

This Court has jurisdiction because Plaintiffs seek declaratory and injunctive relief and potential damages exceeding the minimum jurisdictional limits of the district court.

Venue is proper in Trinity County, Texas, under Section 15.002(a)(1) of the Texas Civil Practice & Remedies Code.

IV. FACTUAL BACKGROUND

Plaintiffs are members of the unincorporated nonprofit association Camp Branch Acres Property Owners Association.

On May 28, 2024, Defendants filed a Certificate of Formation for an unauthorized Texas nonprofit corporation using the unincorporated nonprofit association's name or likeness without a vote from either the established board of directors of the unincorporated nonprofit association or a property owner vote. This action was inconsistent with the governing documents of the unincorporated nonprofit association and the Texas Residential Property Owners' Protection Act.

The establishment of this corporation was not disclosed to the property owners' association (board members or property owners) until a property owner discovered it in September of 2024.

Defendants listed directors on their corporate formation document without their consent, solicited donations in the name of charity, demanded property dues be paid to the corporation, and represented the corporation as legitimate, causing reputational and organizational harm.

V. CAUSES OF ACTION

- Declaratory Judgment
- Permanent Injunction
- Judicial Dissolution
- Prohibition against reinstatement
- Recognition of unincorporated nonprofit association
- Breach of fiduciary duty (if proven)

VI. DAMAGES

plaintiffs seek nominal and actual damages as appropriate, and attorneys fees as permitted by law.

VII. REQUEST FOR DISCLOSURE

Pursuant to Texas Rule of Civil Procedure 194, Plaintiffs request that Defendants serve their Initial Disclosures within 30 days after the filing of their answer.

VIII. PRE-SUIT ACTIONS

Prior to filing this lawsuit, Plaintiffs filed complaints with the Texas Secretary of State and the Texas Attorney Generals Office.

Plaintiffs also offered to resolve the matter by allowing Defendants to put the corporate formation to a valid property owner vote, but Defendants declined. Plaintiffs offered to mediate, but Defendants declined that as well.

IX. PRAYER

WHEREFORE, PREMISES CONSIDERED, Plaintiffs Jennifer Kay Harris and Michael Edward Anthony Harris respectfully pray that Defendants be cited to appear and answer herein, and that upon final hearing, the Court grant judgment in favor of Plaintiffs and award:

- 1. A declaratory judgment invalidating the Certificate of Formation filed on May 28, 2024;
- 2. Injunctive relief barring further use of the unauthorized corporations authority or name;
- 3. Judicial dissolution of Camp Branch Acres Subdivision Property Owners Association, a Texas Nonprofit Corporation;
- 4. An order prohibiting reinstatement of the dissolved entity or formation of any substantially similar entity without a valid property owner vote;
- 5. A declaration affirming that Camp Branch Acres Property Owners Association continues as the lawful unincorporated nonprofit association, free from interference by Defendants;
- 6. Nominal or actual damages as appropriate;
- 7. Costs of court and reasonable attorneys fees;

other and further relief, at law or in equity, to which Plaintiffs may be justly entitled.
