Captain Mike Heffner and Julie Smith Home smoke detectors are essential, change batteries annually. Donated 18 smoke detectors. Fire extinguishers effective for only small fires, recommended 10bc. Have home fire drills with 2 exit routes, safe meeting place outside practice daytime and at night. Do not go back in. Do not plug space heaters into extension cords. Outside decorations plugged into extension cords should be duct taped at ends. Burn Ban means any open flame is banned. Leave defensible space (2 Zones) for the Fire Department to put out a fire at your home. The Chief will conduct control burns if no burn ban is in effect. Signage visibility is key to responders. Recommendations are green reflective background with minimum 3-inch white reflective letters. Homeowners put your address out by the road. 356 VFD is accepting donations, water, Gatorade and monetary. Recent law passed allowing POA to remove debris from lots within subdivision.
